At the implementation level, the company and all of its subsidiaries have established Production Safety Committees with the Safety Department or Emergency Management Department as the operation unit, and the Safety and Environmental Protection Section of the mines and processing plants responsible for the implementation of specific tasks in daily operations.

Continuous Improvement:

We will foster an environment of continuous improvement and optimize our available resources in all matters related to occupational health and safety in order to meet or exceed safety standards.

Compliance with Policies, Regulations, and Standards:

We will comply with all applicable occupational health and safety regulations and standards in the areas where we operate. We commit to enhancing the company's occupational health and safety management systems and ensuring that the ISO 45001 standard is applied across all of our operations. We will seek ISO 45001 certification on all mining projects once they are in production.

Minimizing Risk:

We will minimize health and safety risks and impacts related to our activities to the greatest extent possible by consistently monitoring, assessing, and controlling the hazard factors in production and operation. We have compiled a comprehensive evaluation of safety related risks and corresponding risk reduction measures and will utilize this to provide information-based dynamic monitoring of the implementation of safety production policies.

We will take due care to ensure that activities are safe for our employees, associates, contractors, subcontractors, and others who come into contact with our work processes.

Zero Harm:

We will continuously improve our occupational health and safety standards with a goal of zero work-related injuries and deaths. We will strive to reduce the Lost Time Incident Rate (LTIR) each year. We will conduct safety performance appraisals and review our implementation procedures to ensure that they are effective.

Education:

We will strengthen our occupational health and safety training protocols and organize regular training sessions and emergency drills to promote safety knowledge and increase employees' safety awareness.
